Exhibit Prospectus - Call for Entries **Get Ready, Get Set: Multiples in Clay**

October 8, 2017 – February 24, 2018

Entry applications due **Sept. 19, 2017**

Exhibit Description

Kentucky has many talented ceramic artists. *Get Ready, Get Set: Multiples in Clay* will showcase the creative ideas and variety of works made by Kentucky's clay artists.

Entries can be made from any type of clay and may be either functional or non-functional. Each entry must be of multiples or sets of 4.

A set can be defined in the several ways: 1) An entry might be four pieces made in all the same form and size; 2) Sets of 4 can be of the same form but of different sizes. 3) Sets of 4 can even be made up of different forms that relate to each other 4) Sets can be of not only different forms but also in different scale or size.

Here are just a few examples;

An entry might be: 4 sculptures that are designed with similarities, with the same subject or theme, or that relate to each other in form or surface; a four piece table setting; a set of 4 cups or bowls; a grouping that is similar in shape or size; vessels or sculptures of similar texture or color but of different scale and size; a grouping that relates to each other in subject, theme, form, texture or surface, glaze, shape, function or use.

The overall requirement is that the 4 pieces in each entry relate to each other in style or form as a set. If four different ceramic works are created for the set - they must look related to each other in some manner.

This exhibit is open to any Kentucky ceramic artist. Works must not exceed the maximum dimensions of 4 feet in height or width. As part of this exhibit, artists will be asked to write about their work and why it is created or designed in a particular way.

Kentucky Artisan Center at Berea

The Kentucky Artisan Center at Berea is a state agency in the Tourism, Arts & Heritage Cabinet of the State of Kentucky. The center displays and sells the works of over 750 Kentucky artisans and promotes cultural heritage travel in Kentucky. The Center, located just off I-75 at Exit 77 at Berea, annually welcomes over 275,000 visitors.

Requirements/ Restrictions

Artists must be over 18 years of age and reside in Kentucky. Up to three entries (sets of 4) may be submitted. Works can be 50 pounds or less in weight and no dimension can exceed 4 feet. Works selected can be shipped or hand delivered to the Center. Any works that will need to be return shipped must be delivered or shipped in a sturdy, re-usable container with all packing included and a return label.

Sales

Works must be for sale and will be consigned, with the artisan receiving 60% of the retail price when sold. Works leave the exhibition when purchased and the Center may ask for replacements if available.

How to Enter

To enter, submit a completed entry form, an artist biography or statement and images for each entry. Images must be of the actual works that would be on exhibit if selected.

- Images should include one overall image and if possible one detail image per entry.
- High quality color photos or digital images will be accepted.
- Digital images must be in JPEG format, at least 300 dpi, and submitted on a CD.
